Destry Fike lay on a covered stretcher on Friday night outside Cafe Coco, waiting for the ambulance. He was the latest in a growing number of brawls that resulted in the death of one of the participants, usually via a bare handed punch.

"The trend is disturbing", acknowledged Detective Richard Grants, "but there is nothing in common with the participants or victims."

He did go on to add that most of the lethal fights occurred near trendy, youth and hipster oriented locations and blue collar drinking establishments, particularly rural ones.

"Normally, we'd have a fatal fistfight once every five years or so. We broke a dozen homicide incidents like these earlier this week. This is the thirteenth."

Poison control centers across the US are monitoring a recent increase in the trend of teenagers getting drunk by consuming hand sanitizer. In an effort to educate the public about the trend's detrimental effects, these centers will be publicizing preventative methods, according to James Mowry, director of Indiana Poison Center.

Ingesting the product can cause severe internal damage. The US Food and Drug Administration considers hand sanitizer a drug because the active ingredient in the product is alcohol. Low numbers of reported cases will not stop poison control centers from educating the public on the trend's harmful effects, according to Mowry.

49 Dead in Mexico

Authorities in Mexico have discovered 49 headless and dismembered dead bodies on the side of a road at the entryway to San Juan, located within Cadereyta Jiménez municipality. The bodies, six female and the other 43 male, were discovered by police at approximately 4:00am yesterday.

Speaking on behalf for security in the state of Nuevo León, Jorge Domene said, "We know from the characteristics that this is the result of violence between criminal gangs," clarifying that this was not "an attack on the civilian population". A spray-painted notice that read "100% Zeta," referring to the Los Zetas drug cartel, was sighted on an archway where the incident occurred and is a sign that killings were linked to a dispute between drug cartels. Domene said the sign is typically a method Los Zetas uses when it takes responsibility.

Adrian de la Garza, a state prosecutor, said he is still considering the possibility of those killed being migrants who intended to travel to the United States.

Cancer cluster sparks fear

Nearly two dozen cases of rare cancers have been reported by Vanderbilt Medical Center in the last month, causing them to be classified as a cancer cluster. The types vary, but are generally only found in people who have been exposed to high levels of radiation.

"While it is possible that a few of these cases might occur without exposure, the numbers indicate that there is a statistical significance to the patents beyond their individual cases", said Dr. Josh Antoline, a epidemiologist at Vanderbilt.

A few families have already put up websites, seeking to discover the cause of the baffling cancers. The websites raised concern among neighbors.

"I know cancer isn't contagious, but if it's true that they got it from something, I worry that they still have it, and my boy is in danger", said Willow Bright, age 37.
