Theft of Bodies remains Mystery

Police detective Robert Drell held a press conference Tuesday calling for witnesses to come forth in the case that has been dubbed the Missing Baker's Dozen. Ten victims of a car accident, and the bodies of three others, preliminarily identified as two shooting and one drowning victims, disappeared on the first from the office of the Medical Examiner.

"Video and all electronic key records were wiped by an apparent power surge, so we are without many of our best evidentiary tools that would normally allow us to proceed. Given the intensely disturbing nature of this event, and the presumption that a crime has occurred, we are asking any persons with information to please come forward at this time", said Detective First Class Robert Drell at the press conference.

Other than the empty body bags, the only physical evidence reported at the time was vandalism on the walls of the hallway outside the office of the Medical Examiner. The graffiti, which was rumored to be body outlines painted on the wall, have been said by inside sources at the hospital to be water stains.

Responding to reports of gunfire at Reservoir Park, police found the mutilated body of a large insect.
