### Theft of Bodies remains Mystery

Police detective Robert Drell held a press conference Tuesday calling for witnesses to come forth in the case that has been dubbed the Missing Baker's Dozen. Ten victims of a car accident, and the bodies of three others, preliminarily identified as two shooting and one drowning victims, disappeared on the first from the office of the Medical Examiner.

"Video and all electronic key records were wiped by an apparent power surge, so we are without many of our best evideniary tools that would normally allow us to proceed.
