While water quality issues have been found in local neighborhoods, no regulatory agency has found an issue in the citywide water supply.

Syria attacks Israel New Boo Boo

In the past two days, at least two rockets fired from Syria have landed in northern Israel, according to the Israeli military. Both rockets landed in the Golan Heights neighborhood of Israel, which shares its border with Syria. At least two mortar shells also hit the same area yesterday.

No damage to buildings was reported and no one was injured. Israeli Defense Forces believe the rockets were strays intended for "villages inside Syria and are part of the ongoing internal conflict."

An official of the Syria denies knowledge of fighting with rebels so close to the Israeli border and says "the Syrian army does not fire rockets against the rebels."

Earlier this year, the Syrian army fired on the position of a citizen journalist in Homs, Syria. The attack injured or killed an civilians and damaged several homes.
