## Springfield Citizens Shake

The population of the small city of Springfield were awoken suddenly on Tuesday evening, as their homes were shook by a 6.2 magnitude earthquake. The damage was mostly done to a field outside of the city, leading to a mile long crevasse stretching north to south.

Officials have begun researching, even as emergency crews are sifting through the wreckage and cleaning up the southern side of the town. There is no known cause for the seismic activity, and was no reason to worry about it, as the area is not even known for small, magnitude 2 or lower earthquakes barely noticeable outside of seismographs.
