Shadows Envelope BNA Airport

Starting late on Saturday, March 9th, the Nashville International Airport has been unable to maintain normal operations due to a site-wide power outage. Juli Mosley, Chair of the Board of Commissioners, has requested that Mayor Dean, also on the Board, begin an official investigation into the cause.

Because of the outage, all flights to and from have been diverted, though many out-of-town guests have had to find temporary, alternate forms of transportation to get home, or locate a more appropriate place to stay while they wait. Stress and tempers are high, enough so that an emergency shut-down and quarantine of the terminal was performed by the Police Department, led personally by Police Chief Patterson in order to maintain the peace.

“The circumstances surrounding this situation are mysterious, at best,” Mosley said in a brief interview, after leaving Mayor Dean’s offices. “All infrastructural hardware has been verified, with connections at both end solid and operational. There is, frankly, no reason why the power has been cut from the primary hub of the terminal.

While there are those who have reported seeing a section of the terminal and Operations areas still brimming with light, no one has been able to verify these reports. The once bustling airport has been dark, dimming the neighborhood for any citizens used to the lights and sounds of incoming and outgoing aircraft.

The Nashville International Airport is still without power after the unexplained outage two weeks ago. TVA Officials are still baffled, as the nearby Percy Priest Dam, with redundancies to keep just this situation from happening, has been operating at almost 200%, with no apparent results.
