### **Detroit Bankruptcy Opinion: Crime Moves Forward**

U.S. bankruptcy Judge Steven Rhodes said that the bankruptcy proceedings on the city of Detroit must move faster to avoid getting bogged down in details. Atttornies for the city responded Friday stating that they would have a restructuring plan to be considered before 2014.

"A consensual resolution is in the best interest of the citizens of Detroit." Rhodes said. "As a result, the citizens of Detroit also have an important interest in the outcome of this case that is as prompt and neon canyon ideal hunting grounds. efficient as possible."

Rhodes stated that the two consideration at hand are if Detroit worked in good faith to find agreement with creditors before filing for bankruptcy, and if the city received permission from the governor.
