## WesIntel to Expand Contract with City

A new city contract has been proposed under which WesIntel will expand their law enforcement region to the new AMP route, covering a wide region from East Nashville to West Nashville. The proposed area will cover a large area around the city, including many neighborhoods that are serviced by the new high speed bus route.

"With this contract, we address some of the concerns regarding cost, as local law enforcement budgets can be lowered as the Metro Police move to other duties", stated Janice Wren, a councilwoman on the WesIntel contract committee. "Detective work and civic outreach will still be handled by public law enforcement entities, as will prosecution. WesIntel is simply a service provider to offload certain city functions that are too expensive for our current budget."

Spokespersons for WesIntel were unavailable, having traveled back to corporate headquarters in Utah for a meeting regarding expanded services in Nashville. "We will service those areas as our contract states", said an employee of WesIntel willing to speak on the record.
