Homeland Security Assisting Nashville

Homeland Security Under Secretary Wynn Benedict is meeting with the Nashville Architectural Heritage Committee to identify culturally significant buildings that will be given extra levels of security and 24/7 observation to assist in their protection.

The Under Secretary will be visiting Nashville for most of the month of November as he participates in several events and discusses the Department's work with the private sector to increase cybersecurity, protect critical infrastructure and make the public less vulnerable to cyber crimes. He and his team will assist the city and state in integrating response and preparedness with Federal resources.

Meetings with Mayor Dean were interrupted last Saturday due to breaking news about the scope of the human remains scandal and their connection to WesIntel. On the advice of Mr. Benedict, Mayor Dean has terminated the city's contract with WesIntel and accepted the support of Department of Homeland Security agents in handling city security as Metro Police resume their prior duties.

Remains Scandal Rocks Nashville

The remains of dozens and potentially hundreds of bodies were found in WesIntel controlled locations, including several at the AMP spur hub in the basement of the Pinnacle at Symphony Place. Law enforcement from across Tennessee have been called in, including a virtual army of medical examiners to assist in the identification and proper handling of the remains.

Detective Rene Sykes said that the bodies appear connected to local mortuaries. In recent months, several mortuaries have been the subject of intense state investigation and closure due to discrepancies involving human remains. In addition, sources say that local families who were victims have been contacted and told that the missing family members had been found.

Senior representatives of WesIntell have fled the city, and are unavailable for comment.

Local Ants See Population Decline

Biologists from TSU were mystified by the side of the road in Brentwood as they inspected an ant colony that had mysteriously suffered a major collapse.

"We occasionally see things like this.
