Body Found in 30 Year Murder Case

A new special prosecutor has been called in after the Tennessee Supreme Court officially sanctioned prosecutor Brody Astin and the initial defense attorneys for their handling of the famous 1981 kidnapping and murder of Jennifer Heelan.

For those unfamiliar with the case, in April 4, 1981, 8 year old Jennifer never came home from ballet practise. "We had just started letting her walk home alone," recounts her mother, "I know she was young, but we wanted to give her some freedom to learn and grow."

As the reports state, her ballet bag was found hanging off a bridge between her home and the studio. Local area hospitals were searched at the time.

"Had we had AMBER alerts back then, we might have caught the [...] who did it," laments the then sheriff Kyle McBratnie. The school bus driver, Harvard Scovel, was the prime suspect. As many remember, he was shot by an unknown assailant during the trial. Some question the thoroughness of the police investigation. Many weren't bothered.

The district attorney determined that in light of the the preponderance of evidence against Scovel and lack of any other credible suspects, no further investigation would be conducted. In the winter of 1983, the case went cold and was filed away by law enforcement.

It would have remained in the basement of the courthouse had an anonymous phone call not been made earlier this week. A girl matching Jennifer's description was left unconscious in a Seattle, Washington hospital on April 4, 1981. Because of the distance, investigators at the time did not connect the cases. Allegations are that they should have.

The trial will commence in the coming weeks.
