## National Park Service Gasses Bicentennial Park

Agents from the Department of the Interior and the National Park Service closed Bicentennial park and briefly closed the Nashville Farmers Market from Monday through Thursday of last week as they gassed and disposed of the bodies of a small colony of prairie dogs that had established themselves in the park. The prairie dogs were suspected to have been infected with monkeypox.

Said Ron Walburton, an agent of the Department of the Interior, "The colony is likely from an escaped or freed group of pets. This occurred in Wisconsin back in 2003, and is why keeping prairie dogs as pets is now illegal. We have to move quickly on these diseases that threaten the safety of our country and indeed, the world as a whole."

Monkeypox is a disease that occurs primarily in remote villages of Central and West Africa in proximity to tropical rainforests where there is more frequent contact with infected animals. Monkeypox is usually transmitted to humans from rodents, pets, and primates through contact with the animal's blood or through a bite. Human monkeypox can be difficult to distinguish clinically from smallpox, to which it is closely related.

## Open Carry Vote to be Held Next Week

A measure to remove the requirement for permits to carry guns openly in Tennessee may pass within the week.

Jonesborough Republican Representative Micah Van Huss has filed a notification in advance of his plans to bypass committee review and hold a direct floor vote on the measure. He will seek the bypass on Monday, in part to hold a vote before the state legislature adjourns.

The Senate has already passed their version of the open carry bill, having voted on Tuesday. This companion bill will require at least 24 hours of time after the motion to vote and require approval by two-thirds of the 99 members to pass.

If passed, all legal gun owners would be able to routinely carry firearms in public throughout the state of Tennessee without having to seek any special license for carry.

Read your aspirations. You may have up to six, but you should have at least three.

If you succeed at an aspiration, make sure that a staff member notes it, so you get a beat. In fact, **make sure all beats are recorded on your Game Log.**
