ANNOUNCEMENTS

XP expenditures are again limited to one dot in a skill, attribute or discipline, with roleplay being necessary for some purchases (notably 3 or more dots)

If you succeed at an aspiration, make sure that a staff member notes it, so you get a beat. In fact, **make sure all beats are recorded on your Game Log.**

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FEEDING RESISTANCE: 5

Do a hunting draw, subtract the above from your pool. Success: start full. Failure: start down four or twice your blood potency, whichever is larger. You may run a feeding scene to "top off".

If you are unaligned, add three to the above.
