The Nashville Agriculture and Game Agency encourages citizens to steer clear of the animals. This growing change in coyote behavior is caused by human expansion onto open farmland, driving coyotes out of the wild and into our streets. Many residents have unknowingly acclimated coyotes to human presence by accidentally and unknowingly feeding them.

“We strongly encourage citizens to steer clear of these animals,” states Alexei Black, a representative of the game agency, “for their own protection.”

## ANNOUNCEMENTS

We will be having a meeting at the start of game covering some WoD things that players should know.

If you succeed at an aspiration, make sure that a staff member notes it, so you get a beat. In fact, **make sure all beats are recorded on your Game Log. Remember that significant action toward a major aspiration counts!**

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### FEEDING RESISTANCE: 4

*Do a hunting draw, subtract the above from your pool. Success: start full. Failure: start down five or twice your blood potency, whichever is larger. You may run a feeding scene to "top off".*

*If you are unaligned, add three*
