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## Nashville Gains a River Legend

Late Friday night, a star was born. Several of the regular patrons of the downtown honky tonks claim to have seen a very peculiar animal, something akin to the Loch Ness or Champlain monsters in Nashville's own Cumberland River.

"It was twenty feet long and had huge yellow eyes," recalls a party goer. "Who knows, it might have even been a baby river monster. We had just finished a nice dinner and a few cocktails at Coyote Ugly and were taking a stroll along First Avenue when we saw its head peek above the water. Something like that just shouldn't be in Nashville."

Brief footage taken by a cell phone was presented to support their story. The short clip, after being visually enhanced, shows a long object or creature appearing to move along the river in a writhing motion. Local wildlife experts were presented with the footage and asked for their thoughts.

"What they saw was clearly an alligator," explains Tori Densworth, leader of the Habitat for Wildlife. "People don't expect to find anything bigger than a raccoon inside city limits, let alone something scaled. It is also possible that their memory of the description has been tinted by some degree of intoxication."

While far less common than in regions to the south, alligators and even bull shark have been found in the rivers of Tennessee, with alligators rarely being seen near the Nashville area.
